Vinnytsya is the administrative, economic, regional centre of Ukraine. The city is located on the banks of the river Pivdennyy Bug, 260 kms to the south of the capital of Ukraine Kiev (3 hours by train), 14 hours by train from Moscow and 6 hours – from Odessa and from Lviv).

The city is connected by railway and by air to the western Europe and other countries of the world. The average winter temperature is -5 -10°C below zero, in summer it is usually +22 - +27°C above zero. Vinnytsya is known as a students' city of Ukraine, it is proud of such outstanding educational institutions Vinnytsya National Medical as University, Vinnytsya National Technical University, Vinnytsya State Pedagogical University, Vinnytsya Trade and Economics Institute of Kyiv.

The University has 5 hostels, 4 canteens, 7 buffets. During the period of studies at the University each student is provided with a room in a students' hostel which is equipped with good furniture, appropriate maintenance service, kitchens, shower rooms and other places of common for some extra charge. VNMU is situated in Vinnytsia City which is the administrative centre of Vinnytsia Region (central Ukraine).

Vinnytsia National Pirogov Memorial Medical University was founded in 1921 as Vinnytsia Medical Institute. During these years the University has trained more than 50 000 doctors, more than 2 500 specialists of highest qualification – candidates of sciences and PhDs. Diploma about graduating from the University was got by 14 000 foreign students from 116 countries of Europe, Asia, Africa and Latin America.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT'S FACULTY

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. A minimum of 75% score in English at class 10 and 10 +2 level 2. A minimum of 75% score in Physics , Chemistry and Biology taken together (PCB criteria) is necessary

3.the fowllowing documents should be mailed to the admission liaison at the admission department of vnmu at the time of application if the previous criteria have been met.

UNIVERSITY EXPENDITURE

Various faculties have a different fee structure for teaching in different medium of languages.

Faculty of general medicine in English	4400 US\$ per annum.

Pharmaceutical Faculty in English	3600 US\$ per annum.
Preparatory Faculty	1600 US\$ per annum.



If there are no flights available from vinnitsa to your home country, you can get to vinnytsa via «Boryspil International Airport» (KBP) or «Kyiv International Airport (Zhuliany)» (IEV) in Kyiv. From both cities students can reach to Vinnytsya by railway or bus.

The railway system (Ukrainian Railways) is the best way to reach university hostel.
